





EVENT'S PURPOSE

The European Commission's revised legislative proposals on waste from 2 December 2015 include new targets aiming to increase recycling for packaging materials, including plastic packaging waste. This will contribute to reinforce the new targets on municipal waste and to improve the management of packaging waste in the commercial and industrial sectors. In addition, the European Commission made a commitment to give a specific focus to plastic in particular with a follow-up of the 2013 Green Paper on plastics and measures to foster high-quality recycling of plastic material. The recycling rate of plastic packaging waste in Belgium is about 40% (Eurostat).

This event is organised by <u>ACR+</u> in the framework of the <u>PPI4Waste project</u> and aims to give the opportunity of a dialogue between Belgian public procurers and suppliers in the field of plastic waste management. The objective is to improve the market knowledge of contracting authorities as well as their respective needs.
