








#### What?

A sustainable food system is defined as "a food system that delivers food security and <u>nutrition</u> for all in such a way that the economic, social and environmental bases to generate food security and nutrition for <u>future</u> generations are <u>not</u> **compromised.**" FAO High Level Panel of Experts on food security and nutrition



# The main challenges of food sustainability

#### Social challenges

- Inequalities (North-South, in the North, in the South)
- Food system governance
- Justice, equity
- Access to food for all people
- Consumer and innovation
- Respect for cultural aspirations
- Eater anxiety
- Working conditions

#### **Environmental challenges**

- Pollution (slicks, air, rivers, ground)
- GHG emissions (CO<sub>2</sub>, CH<sub>4</sub>, N<sub>2</sub>O)
- Biodiversity (source of services)
- Water consumption and land use

#### Economic challenges

- Business efficiency
- Jobs
- Land planning (geographical distribution of jobs)


#### Health challenges

- Lifestyles and eating patterns (deficiency malnutrition, obesity, cancer, allergies...)
- Sanitary quality of food (mycotoxins, pesticides...)
- Immunity of the population









#### Carbon Footprint of a European resident



Source: ACR+

Carbon Footprint (CF) of a EU resident (averages)

Overall CF/cap EU = 8 to 10 Ton CO2eq/y

Average: 1 Ton of Food = +/-2 Ton CO2eq


Food consumption = 700kg/cap/y = 1,4 Ton CO2eq./y

Avoidable food waste = 124kg/cap/y = **0,25** Ton CO2eq./y

Avoidable food waste of 500 M Europeans = **125 MTon CO2eq./y** 


50% reduction of avoidable food waste of 500 M Europeans = Less 62,5 Million Ton CO2eq./y = less 1,5% GHG emissions in EU




































#### How? UN SDG: a global political driver



Goal 2: End hunger, achieve food security and improved nutrition and promote sustainable agriculture





#### How?



**Target 3.4** By 2030, reduce by one third premature mortality from noncommunicable diseases through prevention and treatment and promote mental health and well-being

Target 12.3 By 2030, halve per capita global food waste at the retail and consumer levels and reduce food losses along production and supply chains, including post-harvest losses

Target 2.4 By 2030, ensure sustainable production systems and food implement resilient agricultural practices that increase productivity and production, that help maintain ecosystems, that strengthen capacity for adaptation to climate change, extreme weather, drought, flooding other disasters and that and progressively improve land and soil quality.

#### How? EU drivers in support to the SDG

Commission's commitments within the EU Action plan for the Circular Econmy:

- To develop a **common EU methodology to measure food waste** and define relevant indicators.
- To take measures to **clarify EU legislation relating to waste**, food and feed and facilitate food donation and the use of former foodstuff and byproducts from the food chain in feed
- To produce without compromising food and feed safety; and examine ways **to improve the use of date marking** by actors in the food chain and its understanding by consumers, in particular the "best before" label.




#### How? EU drivers in support to the SDG

#### Proposal for a revision of **article 9 of the Waste Framework Directive**:

- MS shall take measures to reduce the generation of food waste in primary production, in processing and manufacturing, in retail and other distribution of food, in restaurants and food services as well as in households.
- MS shall monitor and assess the implementation of their food waste prevention measures by measuring food waste on the basis of methodologies established in accordance with §4.
- The **Commission** shall adopt an implementing act to establish **a common methodology**, including minimum quality requirements


