OBJECTIVES

The URBAN-WASTE project will develop eco-innovative and gender-sensitive waste prevention and management strategies in cities with high levels of tourism in order to reduce the urban waste production and improve municipal waste management. These strategies will facilitate the reintroduction of waste as a resource into the urban metabolism flows and address waste management, risk prevention and land-use as an integral part of urban development.

ACTIVITIES

The project will fill the knowledge gap on urban metabolism by expanding the approach to touristic cities and using it for the development of tailored waste prevention and management strategies. The results will be transformed into a set of strategies and guidelines for policy makers, as well as a ICT tools to support these strategies. All project activities will reflect through eleven tourist pilot areas: Nice (FR), Lisbon (PT), Syracuse (IT), Copenhagen (DK), Kavala (GR), Santander (ES), Nicosia (CY) and Ponta Delgada (PT) Dubrovnik County (HR), Tenerife (ES), and Florence (IT).

The participatory approach will be structured in a mobilisation and mutual learning action plan for waste prevention and management in tourist cities and will attract a number of non-partner cities, too.
