#### THEMATIC WORKING GROUP PRIORITY WASTE FLOWS

"Plastic bags"

Brussels, 25.03.2013



ACR+MED is an international network of members who share the common aim of promoting integrated sustainable waste and resource management with a particular focus on local and cultural Mediterranean context. One of the 4 Thematic Working Groups (TWGs) that have been constituted is animated by the Brussels Region and will discuss the <u>management of priority waste flows</u>. In that respect, a workshop on plastic bags is organized in Brussels on March 25, 2013.

<u>Plastic bags</u> are omnipresent and often excluded from recycling schemes. They are a symbol of a consumer-driven, throw-away society, the environmental impact of their resource use and production phase is important and they often end up in landfill, or as litter.

The workshop will discuss what instruments exist to tackle and reduce the negative impact of plastic bags. Experiences regarding plastic bags management will be shared and recommendations for proper management of this specific waste stream will be formulated.
