




#### Why local authorities should transition to a circular economy?

- To help MS comply with the European legislation (i.e. waste legislation).


  An efficient waste management and recycling system provides a good basis for the circular economy because it allows to recover resources from used items and to reinject them back in the economy as secondary raw materials.
- To set in place infrastructures and services for citizens and businesses, and hence bring environmental benefits and economic opportunities at local level
- To raise the visibility of the city/region at national and European level → lead by the example







#### The Waste Package





- By 2030, at least 70 % of all packaging waste in each EU country should be recycled
- By 2035, all EU countries should recycle at least 65
   % and landfill less than 10 % of municipal waste
- Landfilling restrictions for separately collected and recyclable waste
- Minimum requirements for extended producer responsibility schemes
- Continuously improving separate collection

## **Green Public Procurement under the CE Action Plan**

- Circular economy aspects in criteria-setting
- Support a greater uptake of GPP criteria by public authorities, e.g. by training
- Commission to lead by example in its own procurement, and by reinforcing the use of GPP in EU funding
- New revised version of the GPP Training Toolkit available since May 2019

- Develop markets for secondary raw materials


#### **Pursuing together other systemic transformations**

#### **Circularity in other sectors**

 IT, electronics, mobility, built environment, furniture, textile, food and drinks





- Funding for CE in Cohesion Policy (2016-2019): at least €7.1 billion → €1.8 billion for uptake of eco-innovative technologies among SMEs & €5.3 billion to support the implementation of the EU waste legislation
- In addition, significant support is available through smart specialisation for market-led innovation and deployment



- How does it work?
- ➤ EIR PEER 2 PEER assistance is provided on request of a Member State public institution involved in the implementation of EU environmental policy and law
- Requests can be submitted by national, regional or local public bodies, as well as from regional or local environmental implementation businesses, entrusted with a public task
- Requests have to provide information on
  - > Applicant, contact person
  - > Objective
  - > Justification
  - Expertise required
  - Participants and target group
  - > Timing
