About the organisation	 Directorate General for Development Cooperation and Humanitarian aid is the Belgian federal government department responsible for policy development cooperation. This policy is conducted through three channels: Governmental cooperation with authorities in developing countries and other donors present in the partner countries. Among the partner countries there is Morocco. Non-governmental cooperation in Belgium and in partner countries (through NGOs, universities, organizations from civil society) funding and monitoring of development initiatives of Belgian non-governmental actors are the responsibility of the DGD Multilateral cooperation. Moreover, the Belgian cooperation is also funding a series of specific programs with different partners (emergency aid, food aid, Belgian Fund for Food Security).

Geographic area	Belgium focuses its direct bilateral cooperation in 18 partners' countries. The list of these countries was set in November 2003 and is as follows: South Africa, Algeria, Benin, Bolivia, Burundi, DR Congo, Ecuador, Mali, Morocco, Mozambique, Niger, Uganda, Palestine, Peru, Rwanda, Senegal, Tanzania, and Vietnam.
General procedure and condition for financial contribution	Regarding project implementation, the officers of the Belgian international cooperation are responsible of the identification of interventions (the first phase of the project cycle) and of the control and monitoring of interventions. In each partner country, a cooperation program code and a joint commission was set up. It identifies the sectors and budgets for the actions of the DGD.
	NGO funding 1. Co-Finding of programs (75% or 85%), exclusively for NGO established in Belgium, recognized and registered. NGOs in developing countries can only obtain financing through a partnership with a Belgian and recognized NGO and recognized in their country. To establish such partnerships, it is better to contact directly Belgian accredited NGOs. Information or documentation required	Project formulation is left to other organizations which use their own forms. Sheets donors of these organizations offer more information about it.
Process duration for the examination of requests.	This varies depending on the agency but, in theory, a period of 6 months to a year is planned for the introduction and approval of a project.
