- Open Platform for Urban Sustainability (OPUS) to help facilitate the dialogue and increase co-operation between all relevant actors at the local and regional level; this structure contributed to the European Commission's Thematic Strategy on the Urban Environment
- European Sustainable City Award: ACRR was responsible for the drafting of the questions related to "Sustainable Waste and Resource Management" and the evaluation of applicants on this topic.
